Role Title	Covid-19 Vaccination Champion; Door-to-Door
Location	Various Locations across the Sutton Borough
Time commitment	This will be a mixture of timings across the weekdays and weekends. The shifts are 3.5 hours long. We ask that you try to do one shift a week.
Why you are needed	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To promote the vaccination programme to members of those communities where there has been a low uptake.• To provide them with the latest up to date information regarding where they can book their vaccination appointment.• To provide them with vaccine information to give them the confidence they need to proceed.• To be able to sign post them for further help.
What you will be doing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Introducing yourself and explaining why we are knocking on the resident's door.• Checking that they are happy for you to ask a few questions.• Asking the resident whether they have had the vaccine.• Inputting into the online google form and asking the questions as per the form.• Providing the resident with the current open vaccination centres and the latest walk in clinics that we know of. Also the ways in which to book.• If they have not had the vaccine, asking why and answering any questions using the Q&A provided.• Sign posting to where the resident might be able to ask any further questions to increase confidence in the vaccine.• Providing all residents who have not have the vaccine the literature that you have been given, which includes further detail and contact numbers.
Skills, experience and attributes required	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Comfortable talking with a variety of people and knocking on resident's doors.• A good understanding of why it is important for us to get vaccinated.



	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Happy to read through the literature provided from the NHS so that you can confidently answer any questions.
What is in it for you	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Gaining experience in community engagement.• Being involved in a crucial piece of work to enable more of our community to step forward and be vaccinated.• Building your own confidence & learning how to approach individuals differently depending upon their concerns.• Learning about the vaccination programme.
DBS requirements	Desirable
Driving license requirements	Useful for travelling to the locations listed, but not a requirement.
Volunteer expenses	Travel expenses will be covered.
Induction and training process	There will be an induction with the project lead and introductions to the other volunteers.
Support available	Your on-site volunteer coordinator will provide you with any support you need.
