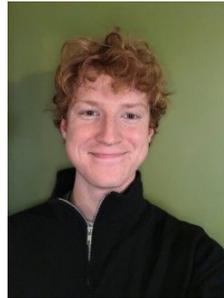

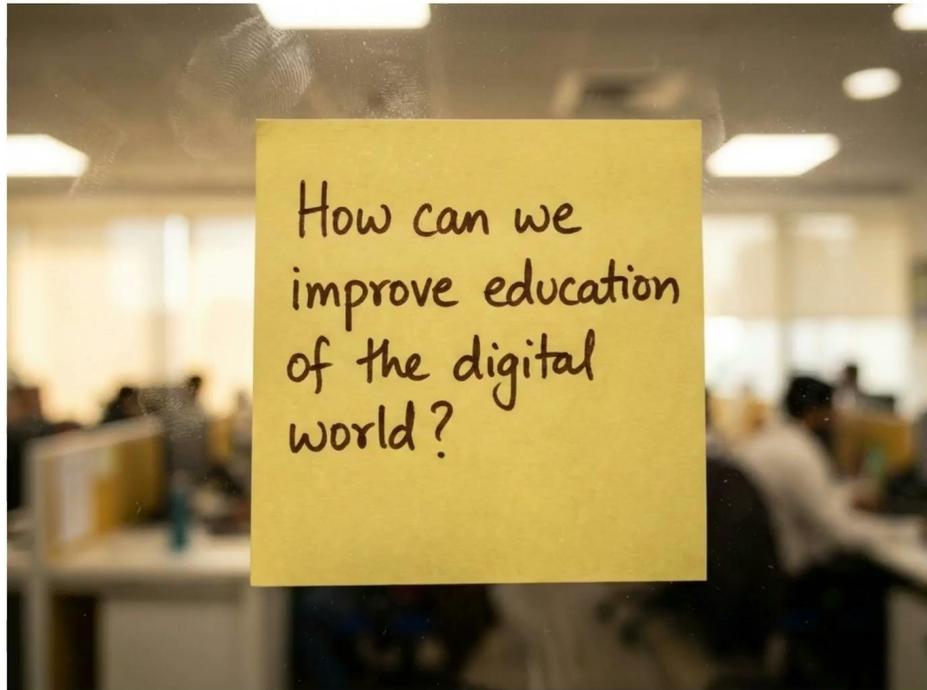

Championing Peer Support

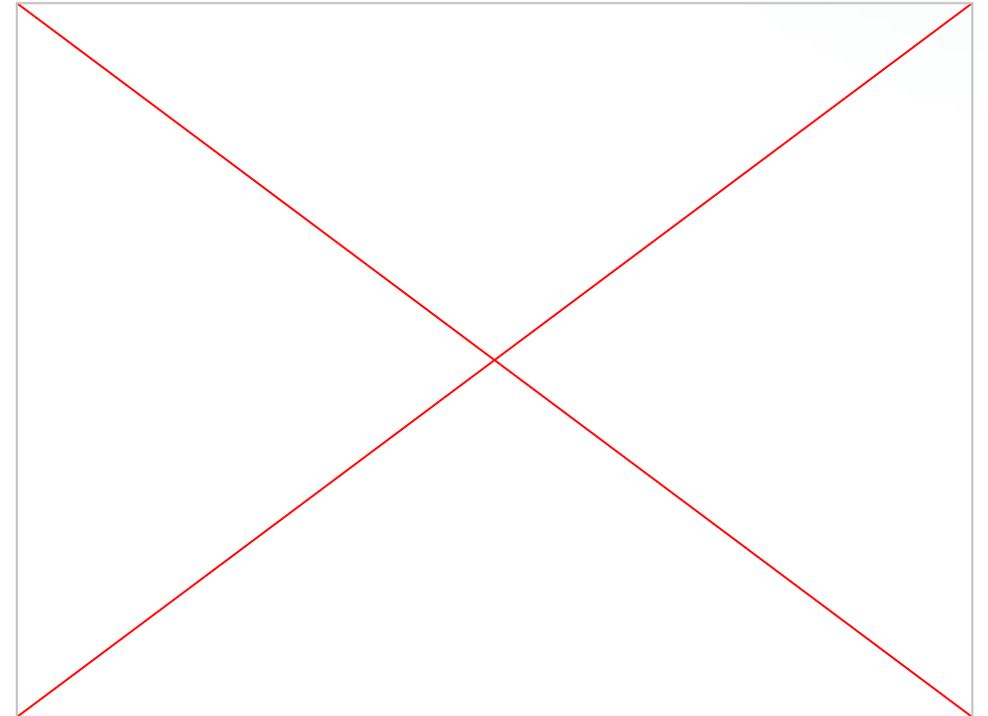
We invest in **MAPS (Mentoring, Advocacy & Peer Support)**, because we know a 15-year-old listens to a 18-year-old more than a Council officer.

Providing expert guidance to Schools

Steve Welding, the Education E safety Advisor at Cognus, goes into schools and speaks to children about online safety. He does year 5 and 6 in Primary school and all year groups in the Secondary schools.

Our Commitment

Q4: When is AI Harmful?

Strategic Alerting

Sutton LSCP monitors national trends. When a threshold is crossed, we issue "Red Alerts" to schools.

Crisis Support

Children First Contact Service (CFCS) provides immediate intervention for bullying or grooming.

Critical Literacy

We can't block the internet. We teach "Resilience"—questioning *why* an algorithm shows you specific content.



"Harm starts when the algorithm prioritises your time over your mental health."
