

Wimbledon Common Circular Walk Saturday 28th May 2022

Meeting Point: Morden Underground Station at 11.30am or Wimbledon War Memorial Parkside at 12.15pm.

Meet outside Morden Underground Station and take the 93- on the same side as the Station bus towards Putney. Get off at Marryat Road. 2-minute walk ahead to War Memorial. (Wimbledon War Memorial.) Bus takes about 30 minutes.

WALK ROUTE: Cross over taking the 'No Entry' signed path and walk up **The Causeway** the pond should be on your **left**. Continue on **The Causeway** Crossing over **Cannizaro Road**.

At the Junction cross over to **West Place**. **The Fox and Grapes Pub** will be on the corner on your **right**. Continue walking up, passing **Wimbledon Almhouses** to the junction where you will find **Wimbledon Common Golf Club** on your left.

Cross over the road and take the **RIGHT** path through the common.

At the Cross Road turn **RIGHT** onto **Inner Windmill Road** walk through the No Entry Sign. Stay on this path for about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile.

At the next Crossroad you will find **The Ranger's Office** and **The Windmill Museum** on your left. **The Windmill and Café** are behind here.

WALKING RISK: All roads and pathways to the Windmill were wide, some uneven. They could be a slip risk if wet due to heavy rain so sensible shoes advised.

Back

Short walk route back to the Bus Stops:

With the **Windmill Café** behind you back track passed the **Museum**.

Cross over the Junction and Walk down **Windmill Road** to **Parkside**. Across the road you can find the 93 Bus Stop back to **Morden**.

Long walk route back to the Bus Stops:

With the **Windmill Café** behind you. Back track passed the **Museum**.

Cross over the Junction walk down **Windmill Road**.

About Half way down, take the path on your right (The Golf Course will be on your Right, the Road on your left). Follow this all the way down to **Cannizaro Road**. Cross over and stay on the path walking towards the **War Memorial**.

Cross the road to the 93-bus stop which will take you back to **Morden Station**.

Walking Risk:

The **short route** of Windmill Road is ok.

Long Route: Coming back to the War memorial we found the pathway quite muddy in places. If there is heavy rain the day before this could prove very muddy so therefore, we may need to stay on the short route as above.

Due to possible slip risks sensible shoes advised.

FYI:

Bus Routes to Morden Station are: 118, 154, 157, 201, 470, K5, 80, 164.

The 93 bus leaves outside Morden Station to Putney every 10 minutes. The journey to the War Memorial takes about 30 minutes.

Windmill Museum is open on Saturday at 2pm to 5pm. If people wish to visit 30 minutes should be fine.

The Windmill Café has a range of Sandwiches/ Baguettes/Paninis from £4.00 to £6.00. Others meals on offer e.g., Fish and Chips = £11.00p. Tea=£2.50 Coffee from £3.20. You cannot eat your own lunch at the Café but there are benches on the adjacent green.

The whole walk took us 1.5 hours. If we have a lunch stop + visit the Museum. Expect to be out from about 11.30am to 4pmish.

There are no toilets at Morden Station. The local Costa Coffee has a toilet. Facing the Wimbledon War Memorial is the Rose and Crown Pub there are toilets at the Windmill Café.
