| 4 | <ul> <li>Training</li> <li>To attend full MAPS Mentoring training and induction, which includes child safeguarding training.</li> <li>To complete all relevant paperwork in line with safe recruitment protocols and procedures which include an enhanced DBS, self declaration form and two personal references.</li> </ul>                               |
| 5 | To carry out the mentoring role in line with risk assessment, child safeguarding practices and MAPS protocols     To report any safeguarding concerns in line with VCS & LBS protocols.  |
